# **PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS**

Project:Nordhoff RemediationContract Amount:ConfidentialLocation:Englewood, New JerseyDuration:2 Months

Northstar was contracted to obtain a water discharge permit, install a complete dewatering and mobile ground water treatment system (MGWTS), excavate 2,600 tons of interior contaminated soil, backfill and compact excavation with clean fill. The MGWTS consisted of fractionation settling tanks, sediment filtration canisters, oil-water separator, one (1) 2,000-lb Granular Activated Carbon vessel and one (1) 1,000-lb Zeolite clay media vessel in order to dewater for remedial purposes. In accordance with the permit requirements, Northstar collected monthly effluent samples for the analytical parameters set forth in the permit. Northstar pumped and treated over 44,500 gallons of impacted water via an 8-inch de-watering pump into the frac tanks.

Subsequent to the ground water being removed from the excavation area, Northstar utilized a vacuum truck to remove the remaining ground water and sediment from the frac tanks. Northstar transported and disposed of the liquid and sediment to Eldredge Inc., of West Chester, PA, for treatment.

Northstar was contracted for remedial action services for a Site in Atlantic City, NJ. The Site is a former automotive dealership and mechanic shop.

Northstar completed the following operation:

Northstar was contracted to remove approximately 12,000 tons of impacted soil from multiple Areas of Concern (AOC) on a 21-acre Industrial site. The scope of work included excavating impacted soils, stockpiling soils for disposal, loading soils into tri-axle dump trucks for disposal, backfilling AOCs with certified clean fill in 12" compacted lifts and grading restored areas to match existing contours. To accomplish the task in 8 weeks, Northstar excavated over 3,000 tons of soil per day. Impacted soil was loaded onto 40 ton off road haul trucks and stockpiled at another area of the site. Because of the large volume of fill material needed, clean fill was also stockpiled onsite so that trucking wouldn't push backfilling operations behind schedule. Three separate crews of equipment and operators were utilized to complete the clearing, excavating and backfilling in 10 days. Due to input quantity limits at the disposal facility, impacted soils were being trucked off site for another 4 weeks.



The Site was operated as a specialty gas manufacturing plant starting in approximately 1932. Prior to the construction of the gas manufacturing facility, a button manufacturer and a coal and coke supplier reportedly occupied the Site. Most of the manufacturing operations were suspended at the Site in 2002. Operations from 2002 through August 2006 were comprised of transferring certain gases into cylinders and distribution of gas products. The remedial excavation activities addressed removal of chlorinated volatile organic compound (CVOC) DNAPL in two separate locations near to the northeast and southeast corners of Building 12 (to be demolished prior to excavation activities).

Sheeting and excavation of the southeastern DNAPL area is limited to a zone between 13 feet bgs and 20 feet bgs over an area of approximately 540 feet. The northeastern and southeastern areas of the DNAPL were excavated to depths of approximately 10 feet bgs and 20 feet bgs, respectively. The capping activities addressed the historic fill that is found across the Site. The new gravel cap covered all grassy, exposed soil and broken asphalt with the exception of the southwestern area adjacent to the New Jersey Transit tracks.

  - 1) To notify the public agency compliance officer, the Division, and minority and women referral organizations listed by the Division pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.3, of its workforce needs, and request referral of minority and women workers;
  - 2) To notify any minority and women workers who have been listed with it as awaiting available vacancies;
  - 3) Prior to commencement of work, to request that the local construction trade union refer minority and women workers to fill job openings, provided the contractor or subcontractor has a referral agreement or arrangement with a union for the construction trade;
  - 4) To leave standing requests for additional referral to minority and women workers with the local construction trade union, provided the contractor or subcontractor has a referral agreement or arrangement with a union for the construction trade, the State Training and Employment Service and other approved referral sources in the area until such time as the workforce is consistent with the employment goal;
  - 5) If it is necessary to lay off some of the workers in a given trade on the construction site, to assure, consistent with the applicable State and Federal statutes and court decisions, that sufficient minority and women employees remain on the site consistent with the employment goal; and to employ any minority and women workers laid off by the contractor on any other construction site on which its workforce composition is not consistent with an employment goal established pursuant to rules implementing N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq.;
  - 6) To adhere to the following procedure when minority and women workers apply or are referred to the contractor or subcontractor:
    - (i) If said individuals have never previously received any document or certification signifying a level of qualification lower than that required in order to perform the work of the construction trade, the contractor or subcontractor shall determine the qualifications of such individuals and if the contractor's or subcontractor's workforce in each construction trade is

not consistent with the applicable employment goal, it shall hire or schedule those individuals who satisfy appropriate qualification standards. However, a contractor or subcontractor shall determine that the individual at least possesses the requisite skills, and experience recognized by a union, apprentice program or a referral agency, provided the referral agency is acceptable to the Division. If necessary, the contractor or subcontractor shall hire or schedule minority and women workers who qualify as trainees pursuant to these rules. All of the requirements, however, are limited by the provisions of (C) below.

- (ii) If the contractor's or subcontractor's workforce is consistent with the applicable employment goal, the name of any interested women or minority individual shall be maintained on a waiting list for the first consideration, in the event the contractor's or subcontractor's workforce is no longer consistent with the applicable employment goal.
- (iii) If, for any reason, said contractor or subcontractor determines that a minority individual or a woman is not qualified or if the individual qualifies as an advanced trainee or apprentice, the contractor or subcontractor shall inform the individual in writing of the reasons for the determination, maintain a copy of the determination in its files, and send a copy to the public agency compliance officer and to the Division.
- 7) (7) To keep a complete and accurate record of all requests made for the referral of workers in any trade covered by the contract, on forms made available by the Division and submitted promptly to the Division upon request.
- (C) The contractor or subcontractor agrees that nothing contained in (B) above shall preclude the contractor or subcontractor from complying with the union hiring hall or apprenticeship policies in any applicable collective bargaining agreement or union hiring hall arrangement, and, where required by custom or agreement, it shall send journeymen and trainees to the union for referral, or to the apprenticeship program for admission, pursuant to such agreement or arrangement. However, where the practices of a union or apprenticeship program will result in the exclusion of minorities and women or the failure to refer minorities and women consistent with the county employment goal, the contractor or subcontractor shall consider for employment persons referred pursuant to (B) above without regard to such agreement or arrangement; provided further, however, that the contractor or subcontractor shall not be required to employ women and minority advanced trainees and trainees in numbers which result in the employment of advanced trainees and trainees as a percentage of the total workforce for the construction trade, which percentage significantly exceeds the apprentice to journey worker ratio specified in the applicable collective bargaining agreement, or in the absence of a collective bargaining agreement, exceeds the ratio established by practice in the area for said construction trade. It is further agreed and understood that the CRA assumes no obligation to indemnify or save harmless the Contractor, its agents, servants, employees and subcontractors for any claim which may arise out of their performance of this Agreement. Furthermore, the Contractor expressly understands and agrees that the provisions of this indemnification clause shall in no way limit the Contractor's obligations assumed in this Agreement, nor shall they be construed to relieve the Contractor from any liability, nor preclude the CRA from taking any other actions available to it under any other provisions of the Agreement or otherwise at law.
