Resolution Rescinding Resolution 12-07-11A, which Authorized the Camden Redevelopment Agency to Execute a Partial Termination Agreement Pursuant to a Redevelopment Agreement with the Delaware River Port Authority and Authorizing the Camden Redevelopment Agency to Execute a Termination Agreement Pursuant to a Redevelopment Agreement with the Delaware River Port Authority

Project Summary:

- The CRA entered into a Redevelopment Agreement with the DRPA, dated 3/27/01 whereby the DRPA was designated as the Redeveloper for Blocks 85, 86, 87 and 89 ("Project Site") in the Camden North Gateway Redevelopment Area
- Previously, the CRA and the DRPA sought to terminate the DRPA designation as to Blocks 87 and 89
- The CRA by Resolution 12-07-11A authorized the execution of a <u>Partial</u> Termination Agreement of the DRPA designation, specific to Blocks 87 and 89; this Agreement was never executed
- Now the CRA and the DRPA seek to <u>fully</u> terminate the DRPA designation for all of the Project Site
- The proposed Termination Agreement will limit the amount of funds to be repaid to the DRPA to not more than \$550,000 with a repayment term of not less than 15 years.
- The DRPA will not charge interest on the repayment amount and will not record a mortgage.

Resolution Rescinding Resolution 12-07-11A, which Authorized the Camden Redevelopment Agency to Execute a Partial Termination Agreement Pursuant to a Redevelopment Agreement with the Delaware River Port Authority and Authorizing the Camden Redevelopment Agency to Execute a Termination Agreement Pursuant to a Redevelopment Agreement with the Delaware River Port Authority

WHEREAS, the City of Camden Redevelopment Agency ("CRA") is charged with the duty of redevelopment throughout the City of Camden; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Camden ("City Council") on November 13, 1992, adopted,, in accordance with the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq. (the "LRHL"), an ordinance approving the Camden North Gateway Redevelopment Plan (the "Plan") as to certain land within the City of Camden more particularly described therein (collectively, the "Redevelopment Area"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council designated the CRA as the redevelopment entity pursuant to the LRHL to implement redevelopment plans and carry out redevelopment projects within the Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the Plan authorizes the CRA to designate and enter into agreements with redevelopers to undertake redevelopment projects forming a part of or in the furtherance of the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware River Port Authority ("DRPA") was designated Redeveloper of Block 85 Lot 1, Block 86 Lot 51 and all of Blocks 87 and 89 on the official tax map of the City of Camden (the "Project Site") and the CRA entered into a Redevelopment Agreement with the DRPA, dated March 27, 2001 (the "Redevelopment Agreement") regarding the aforementioned Project Site; and

WHEREAS, the CRA and the DRPA sought to terminate the DRPA's redevelopment designation for only Blocks 87 and 89 and by Resolution 12-07-11A, the CRA Board of Commissioners did authorize the execution of a Partial Termination of the Redevelopment Agreement ("Partial Termination") specific to Blocks 87 and 89; and

WHEREAS, the Partial Termination was never executed and now the DRPA and CRA desire to seek a full termination of the DRPA's redevelopment designation for the entire Project Site and negotiate a Termination Agreement specifying the terms and condition of the Termination,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Camden Redevelopment Agency that Resolution 12-07-11A is hereby rescinded; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Camden Redevelopment Agency that the Executive Director, a duly authorized representative of the Camden Redevelopment Agency, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Termination Agreement pursuant to a Redevelopment Agreement with the Delaware River Port Authority, provided that the Termination Agreement includes an amount to be repaid to the DRPA of not more than \$550,000 and a repayment term of no less than 15 years and that DRPA shall not charge interest on the amount to be repaid and shall not record a mortgage; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Director, or her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions and execute all documents necessary to carry out the purposes of this Resolution.
